### Reason for this Blast:

The safety of each of us relies on all of us. Every member must know and follow the prescribed safety practices and procedures at the unit, at home, and in your respective workplaces and conduct themselves in a safe manner.



### Safety Points:

Each member **MUST** take responsibility for their own safety and the safety of others...this is accomplished by what you do and what you **DON'T DO**.

- Participate and cooperate in all matters of safety and health.
- Report any dangers or defects that may endanger you or others-this may be in equipment or in work procedures. **IF YOU SEE SOMETHING-SAY SOMETHING.**
- Make use of and don't abuse Personal Protective Equipment - this is for your own protection.
- **YOU MUST NEVER INTERFERE WITH, MISUSE, OR DEFEAT ANY SAFETY DEVICE/GUARD PROVIDED FOR SAFETY PURPOSES.**

### Expectations:

- Participate in and contribute to the safety program for the protection of all members.
- Take responsibility for the safety of your areas and assignments. Accountability applies to all of us.
- Inspect all areas for safety hazards.
- Identify and know the correct procedures then practice them.
- Know how to recognize unsafe acts and/or unsafe conditions and report them to your immediate superior, commander or safety officer immediately.

**Participate in Safety activities, understand and follow all training, take ownership of your areas and assignments. Know and do what's right to protect all.**
